Applications for admission

I : Eligibility of Applicants

Definition of international students: Applicants, who do not have the citizenship of the Republic of China as defined in Article 2 of the Nationality Act, do not possess citizenship of Hong Kong, Macau, Mainland China, nor the status of overseas Chinese.

Prerequisite:

1. For admission to Bachelor Programs: Senior High School diploma.
2. For admission to Master's Programs: Bachelor's degree.
3. For admission to Doctoral Programs: Master's degree.

Note : 【 Article Two of the Nationality Law 】

According to Article Two of the Nationality Law, a person who meets one of the following requirements acquires the nationality of the Republic of China:

- (1) A person whose father or mother was, at the time of his/her birth, a citizen of the Republic of China. 【 * 】
 - (2) A person born after the death of his/her father or mother, and whose parent was, at the time of death, a citizen of the Republic of China. 【 * 】
 - (3) A person born in the territory of the Republic of China and whose parents are both unknown or are stateless.
 - (4) A naturalized citizen.
- 【 * 】 An individual born on or before February 9th, 1980 needs only consider the nationality of his or her father.

(G) 2 copies of Chinese or English translation of the the academic transcript of the highest academic degree, authenticated by ROC representative offices abroad.

(H) A financial statement : Please select one of the following payment methods:

A financial statement authenticated by ROC representative offices abroad

Proof of scholarship

One photocopy of a financial statement, issued by a domestic financial institution, within the past three months.

If the financial statement does not match the applicant's account, a sponsor's financial guarantee (as in Attachment II, p.44) and financial statement is required.

(I) Self-addressed envelope (10.5cm x 23cm and above) for delivery of the notification. No postage is required.

(J) Documents required by specific department / institute: please refer to the information listed under each department / institute in this brochure.

The above-mentioned term "ROC representative offices abroad" means ROC embassies, consulates, representative offices, trade offices or other agencies authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of ROC.

If the authentication process is not finished before the deadline, a signed Deposition of Admission Documents will be required, (as in attachment III, p.46) and is to be submitted with the application.

Unless otherwise specified, application documents submitted shall not be returned.

Applications for admission

5. Miscellaneous

- (1) The admission of international students to NTNU is conducted in compliance with Ordinance No. 0950088554C issued by the Ministry of Education (MOE) on June 22, 2006, subject to any changes that may come into effect by the last day of application.
- (2) International students admitted to NTNU shall be revoked of their admission and/or dismissed from NTNU if any of the following terms is violated:
 - (A) Students who do not possess ROC nationality shall apply for admission to NTNU in the capacity of either an overseas Chinese or a foreigner, but NOT in both capacities.
 - (B) Students who are ex-ROC citizens shall not apply for admission to an ROC college or university as international students within eight years after their ROC nationality is denied.
 - (C) International students who are admitted to an ROC college or university but later dismissed by the college or university shall not seek admission to another program of study in the same capacity.
 - (D) NTNU Students whose study is being suspended shall not apply for admission to the same program of study in the same department/institute.
- (3) Wherever applicable, the applicants should take the written tests, interview, and/or technical tests as specified by each department/institute concerned. The original copy of passport or other identification(s) should be presented at the test.
- (4) Diplomas and transcripts issued by schools overseas are subject to review in accordance with the Ministry of Education's *Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education*.
- (5) Students should possess basic skills in Chinese or English. Wherever required by the related department/graduate institute, the applicants should take the Chinese language proficiency test and/or take additional Chinese courses before being fully admitted.
- (6) Students who have completed the application shall not be any means request to change the department/institute and program being applied for, or for a refund of the application fees.
- (7) International students admitted to NTNU shall be revoked of their admission and/or dismissed from NTNU if any defect is found in the applicants' qualifications for application or in the authenticity of the documents submitted. Those who have graduated shall have their diploma revoked.

V : Rules governing the admission

1. The final list of admitted students shall be decided by the Admissions Committee. A number of probationally admitted students may be put on the waitlist in case any admitted students fail to complete the registration procedure.
2. The departments/institutes may choose not to admit the students to their full capacity. In this case, no applicant will be probationally admitted.

VI : Announcement of Admitted Students

2. Admitted students will also receive notification through express registered mail.

VII : Registration

1. Admitted students are required to refer to the Admission notification regulations for the information needed to mail the new student submission letter to the Admissions Committee by registered mail within the designated period (postmarked for proof) for the "Mail submission" procedure or internet submission (The website will be

noted in the Admission notification). Students who fail to complete “Mail submission”, will be referred to abandon the admitted qualification voluntarily, the vacancy will be filled, in order, by the registered students on the waiting list. Students on the waiting list should mail their waiting list registry form, by registered mail in accordance with the designated period noted in the notification (postmarked for proof), to NTNU Admissions Committee for “Waiting list registration” procedure, or be referred to abandon the waiting list qualification. After students on the waiting list become admitted, they will be notified for submission at a later date. The expiration date for students on the waiting list will be the course starting date according to the yearly curriculum.

2. Admitted students who have completed the “Mail submission”, shall refer to the Admission notification regulation for submission and registry procedure and shall be present at the university for registration on the date specified by presenting the original copy of passport, diploma, and the Chinese or English translation of school transcripts authenticated in ROC representative offices abroad (for authentication purpose only, will be returned immediately), or the status of admission shall be revoked. Those who have not had their documents authenticated by the time of application shall present the authenticated documents to the Division of Planning, Office of Academic Affairs, within one month after the application result is announced, or the status of admission shall be revoked. Applicants who are going to graduate in the end of this school year shall have the documents reviewed by the Division of Planning, Office of Academic Affairs before registration, or the status of admission shall be revoked.
3. The admitted students should, following Article 21 of “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan”, provide proof of medical and personal accidental insurance papers insured outside ROC with validity from entering ROC up to at least four months upon enrollment. If already being insured at the national health insurance of ROC, the enrolled students only need to provide proof of the related insurance papers. The above-mentioned insurance papers issued outside ROC should be verified by ROC representative offices abroad.
4. The admitted students even if not having enrolled on the specified dates, can retain their admission status with the permission of their department / graduate institute. (Please refer to the respective notes of the department / graduate institute in this brochure.) These students must apply directly to the Registry Division of Office of Academic Affairs of NTNU. Upon permission of NTNU, these students can postpone their studies to the next school year. The regulations for the new students of that school year are also applied to these postponed students.
5. When required by the relevant departments / institutes, admitted students shall take the Test of Proficiency-Huayu, which is held by Steering Committee for the Test of Proficiency-Huayu before registration. The test fee is NT\$1,500. The website of the Test of Proficiency-Huayu is: <http://www.sc-top.org.tw/>
Refer to the remarks in the the information of each department / institute for this requirement.
6. Transfer credits from other colleges / universities shall be governed by related regulations of this University.

VIII : Miscellaneous

1. For any appeals to the admission procedure, the applicants may submit a written statement to the Division of Planning, Office of Academic Affairs within 15 days after the announcement of the admitted students. Anonymous appeals shall not be processed.
2. Issues not covered in these guidelines are either prescribed in the “Admission Regulations for International Students of NTNU” or left to the discretion of the NTNU Admissions Committee.
