(Term Time : February – June)





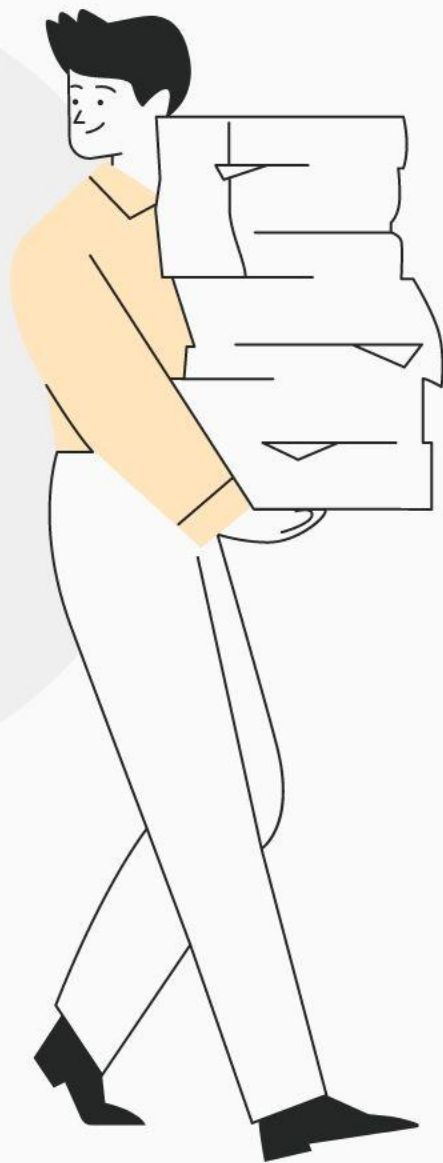
Required Documents

2. Study plan x 1(undergraduate, graduate)/Research Plan x 1(graduate)
3. Letters of recommendation x 2
4. Official Academic Transcripts x 1 (for undergraduate or graduate studies)
5. Photocopy of applicant's passport(color photocopy)
6. Official Enrollment Certificate (Issued by home Univeristies/institutions within 3 months) x 1
7. Remittance slip of admission fee (USD110)

***All the documents must be either in English or Chinese**

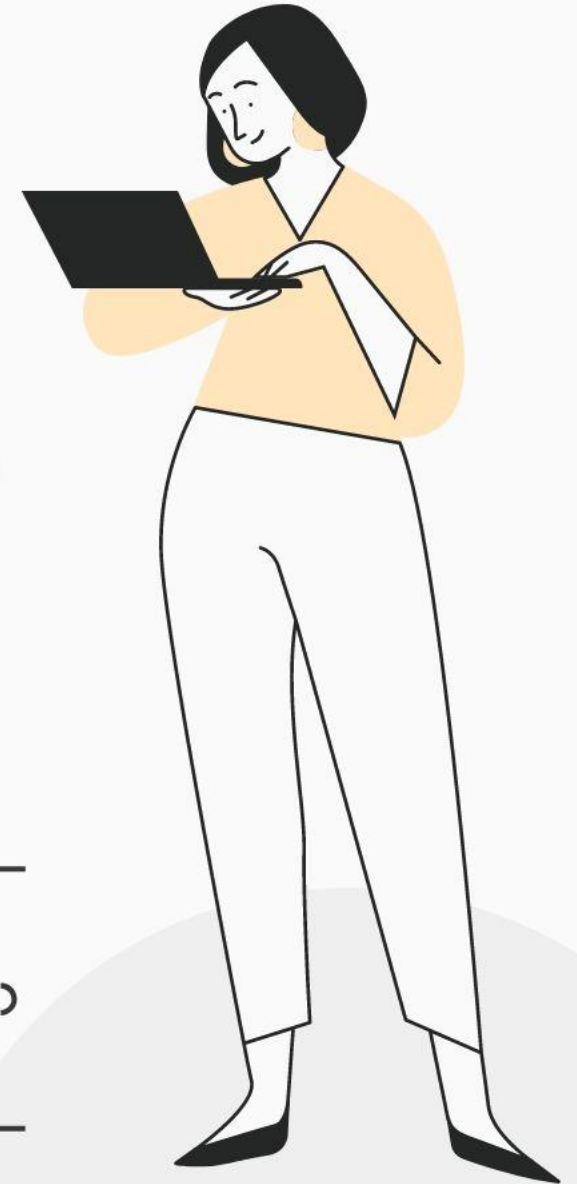

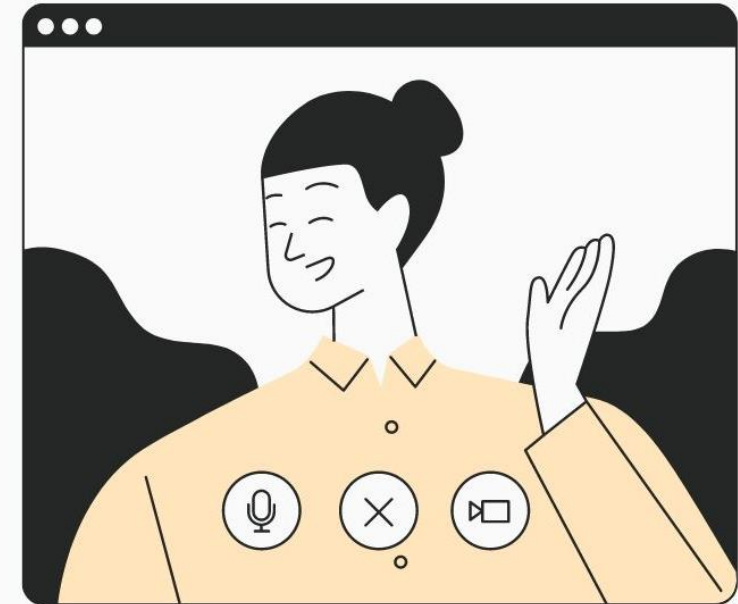
